

Mainsaver Releases Major Software Update

San Diego, CA – April 4, 2017: Mainsaver Software is pleased to announce new releases of both its Core Software Application as well as its mobile solution, Mainsaver Connect. Version 12.8.100 is considered a major release for the company and includes a number new features designed to enhance user friendliness and effectiveness. New functionality in the core application includes:

- **New Table View Personalization Capabilities** – Provides the ability to choose which columns reside in the table view screens. Each Mainsaver module table view can be personalized as needed. System Administrators can set up a standard set of data columns for each Mainsaver Module, configuring each format globally, by user group, or by individual. Individual Users can then personalize and refine their table view screens by further choosing / arranging their data columns as desired.
- **Table View Reporting Capabilities** – Allows users the ability to pick and choose columns of data directly from the table view screens, then efficiently print this data to a hard copy report or pdf file. The data can also be printed to Microsoft Excel, with only the columns selected being exported.
- **Additional refinements to the newly release Mainsaver GUI** – new convenience options have been added to the ribbon menus for easier access printing of Purchase Requests, Purchase Orders, Invoices, and Barcode Labels.

Additional features offered by the new version of Mainsaver Connect includes:

- **Asset Functionality** – Users can now create assets, view asset details or costs, and view asset lists. The asset list can be expanded or collapsed as desired to indicate asset hierarchy structure within the list. In addition, photos of assets can now be attached for ready viewing.
- **Weekly Time Entry** – technician labor or time cards can now be entered via Connect, utilizing the new Weekly Timecard Entry screen. This feature allows a full week of timecards to be entered on a single screen, rather than having to enter time at the individual work order level.
- **Enhanced Barcode Capabilities** – Connect now has the ability to utilize the camera on a smartphone or tablet as a barcode reader. In addition, new functions have been added to drive work flow by simply scanning an asset number, work request, or work order with the barcode reader. The scan will initiate a list of common functions/procedures normally executed by Connect users.
